Dear Newark CSD Families and Staff:

We have had the following positive COVID tests reported to us since we last updated our community:

- We had a Perkins student test positive. As a result of that positive, seven (7) students were required to quarantine.
- We had a High School student test positive. As a result of that positive, eight (8) students were required to quarantine.
- We had a Middle School student test positive. As a result of that positive, 17 students and one (1) staff member were required to quarantine.
- We had a Kelley School student test positive. As a result of that positive, 11 students were required to quarantine.
- We had another Kelley School student test positive. As a result of that positive, seven (7) students were required to quarantine.

The Wayne County Department of Public Health (WCDPH) has advised us that no further action needs to be taken by the District. Contact tracing is conducted by the WCDPH and they make all quarantine decisions based on information provided by the school district and families. If you are not contacted by the WCDPH, no further action is required on your part. We are following all of the WCDPH guidelines and directions as we have since the beginning of the school year.

Please continue to practice proper hand hygiene, wear face coverings, avoid large groups, and try your best to social distance when you must be outside your home. If your children or you are not feeling well, please seek medical attention. As always, we apologize for any disruption to your family life every time we deal with a positive case that leads to the quarantine of any of our students and staff. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
