



### Correia To Receive 2019 Cunningham Award

Newark High School senior Emma Correia has been named the 2019 recipient of the Elmer J. Cunningham Educational award.

The daughter of Melissa and Andy Correia of Newark, Emma will attend the University of Buffalo in the fall where she will major in linguistics.

The Elmer J. Cunningham Educational Award is a trust fund created by the will of the late Clara F. Cunningham in memory of her brother, Elmer J. Cunningham, who was the first principal of Lincoln School. He served in that capacity for more than a quarter of a century.

In accordance with the terms of the will, a scholarship award is made annually to the “member of the senior class who, being a graduate of Lincoln Grammar School, has the highest scholastic average for his or her high school work and is accepted at a college or school where he or she will continue his or her formal education.”

Correia will receive the award at commencement.
