



# May 18th NCSD School Election Results

The proposed 2021-22 Newark Central School District budget passed May 18th by a 79.2 percent margin in the annual school district election yesterday. The vote was 446-117.

The bus purchase reserve proposition passed by a vote of 451-121.

Also in the election, three, three-year terms and a two-year vacant term were filled.

Three-year terms were won by newcomers Scott Verbridge with 353 votes; Julie Nevelizer with 347 votes; and Shannon Nash with 343 votes.

Incumbent BOE member Brad Steve, who is completing his first three-year term on the Board, won the two remaining years of the vacant term with 299 votes.

Newcomer Charlene Gonzalez received 277 votes and incumbent John Addyman received 232 votes.

After the results were tallied May 18th, Superintendent Susan Hasenauer thanked everyone that ran for a seat on the BOE.

*“I want to say a very special **thank you** to John Addyman for his service on our Board,” she said. “And special **congratulations** to Scott Verbridge, Julie Nevelizer, Shannon Nash and Brad Steve.”*

Hasenauer also expressed great appreciation for the ongoing support by district voters of the NCSD educational program and thanked everyone that voted.
