



New Winter Coats And Boots Drive

Underway At Kelley School



Kelley School faculty has embarked on a drive this holiday season in which staff is being asked to donate new coats and boots for children in need.

Cassie McCumber, Kelley School Psychologist for the SHAPE Program, who is organizing the drive, sent a letter to staff December 3rd in which she noted the grades 3-5 school would like to help support "our community a little differently this holiday season."

"We know a lot of our families are facing challenging times this year and we would like to help ensure as many of our students as possible have warm clothing in which they can walk to school in, wait for a bus in or play outside in," she wrote.

The hope is that the new coats and boots will be given to as many students that need them as soon as possible.

She said the newly donated items will immediately be put in the Kelley School Closet located in the auditorium and students can access them when they need them.
